Special thanks go out to Steve Dakota who plays Samuel Brennan — our first California Millionaire in Scene 13 — for putting me in touch with Dr. Gallant, DVM retired, who just happened to have the South Fork of the American River going through his backyard in Lotus, California, just a few miles northwest of Coloma on Highway 49.

After a lengthy visit with the gracious and giving host, Dr. Gallant, in which

he gave me a tour of the location, Henningsen Lotus Park, and Sutter's Mill, we came to terms and and both look forward to the 24<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of July.

The location is just a little over an hour away for me and from Access Sacramento — where the cast & crew call was located; so it's not that bad considering it would have been an hour and a half plus for everyone to get to Bridgeport — this is a savings for all and near where we are actually portraying.
